ANNOUNCEMENTS

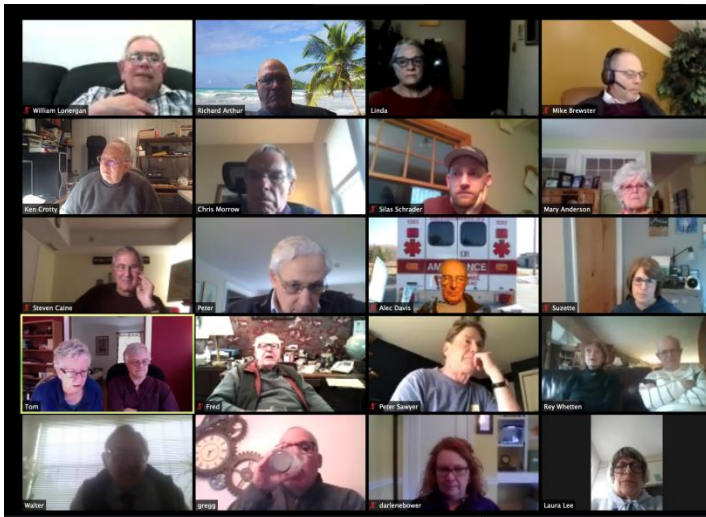
MEMBERSHIP – Mike Brewster said that he would be reaching out to members
