Best Buddies

Darlene introduced the two dynamic presenters sharing her experience of participating in the annual Friendship Walk.

Best Buddies International is an organization dedicated to establishing a global volunteer movement that creates opportunities for one-to-one friendships, integrated employment, leadership development, and inclusive living.

Nina Benvenuto is the program manager in Albany. She started the program with a quick but powerful video. The theme being "Everybody needs Somebody".

Sophie Dubuisson is the New York State Director. She explained how large this international organization is, working with 200 million people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). There are 130 school chapters in New York State. Locally there are 8 college chapters, 16 high school chapters, and 14 middle school chapters. The chapters are led by school personal who know the participants well enough to establish friendships. The friendships can last through the school years and into adulthood.

We learned that the BHBL School District has expressed interest in establishing a chapter. Gregg shared his daughters experience with Best Buddies in the Ballston Spa School system. Beyond school programs, there is also a program for Adults called the Citizen's program. A new program called "E Buddies" connects buddies electronically.

March is Best Buddies month. There will be a virtual dance party. This year 135 virtual events have been held. It has been a successful but challenging year. Some of the virtual events include "Crafternoon", Movie Monday, Fake Swimming Parties.

How could we get involved? Host an event like a craft-making session, join a program like E Buddies which brings people together anywhere in the word, be a public speaker and help a buddy create a self-speech. Spread the word and pledge to be more inclusive in all relationships, engage in the hiring chain for IDD people. The annual Friendship Walk is May 1st in Albany. It is either virtual or in-person. Let's organize ourselves to participate.
