LINDA CONLEY - WHO KILLED BETTY CONLEY

As some of us remember, on July 8, 1993 Betty Conley was killed at the XtraMart on Rt 67, Harmony Corners, Charlton, NY. Someone entered the convenience store around 2 AM, stole about \$100 and shot her in the back of the head. She was found by a customer around 3 AM. Betty was 37, the mother of two & a wife of 18 years. Her daughter Linda is trying to raise awareness of this cold case in hopes that someone will remember something and come forward with a new lead for the Saratoga Sheriff's Department to follow. She has raised approximately \$17,500 in reward money. There have been many rumors and she would like everyone who is aware of these rumors to step up and tell what they have been told. She has utilized internet, local signage and meetings like ours to publicize her mother's murder in hopes of finding new leads. She is planning a vigil at the Harmony Corners Fire Department next to the location of the building that housed the XtraMart.

Linda is a self-employed wedding photographer who with the help of her friend & colleague, Leann Fyvie, put together the film documentary featuring Linda and her father which tells the story of what happened to her mother to raise awareness of the 28-year-old unsolved murder. Linda has started an annual \$500 scholarship fund in her Mother's memory for a Galway High School graduate who is pursuing a career in the Trades. She has set up a GoFundMe page which has raised approximately \$4,000 with a goal of \$10,000
