WELCOME NEW DISTRICT GOVERNOR, BRUCE McCONNOLEE

President Dan introduced Loraine McConnolee who enthusiastically introduced her husband, our new District Governor, Bruce McConnolee. An obvious proponent of challenging Rotary projects, Bruce shared stories of helping restore and relocate an historic Whipple bridge and a few years later, constructing a bridge across Indian Kill Creek during a "Rotary Day of Service".

Focusing on projects served to introduce the 2021-2022 Rotary district theme: "Service to Change Lives – Build Bigger Projects".

Bruce outlined a plan that will fulfill the new Rotary "Build Bigger" Theme. "Come up with a new project that will have great community impact. It must be done this year. Work with two or three other clubs, other service organizations, and future Rotarians. Keep an open mind. Ask, how can we do that project? Learn from our past. Learn from other clubs. Expand on it. Look at new ways of doing things."

"To be one, bring one" is another plank in the new Rotary year plan. "Look at your membership. If it is 33, make it 66 by the end of the Rotary year. Get the word out. Know what Rotary is and be able to explain it to a neighbor. Invite friends to take part in your Rotary projects."

Bruce told us about three new Rotary Clubs in our district:

Patriots for Veterans Club (in the Glenville Club) – a "cause based" club Heartbeat Club – an E-based Niskayuna family club Bringing back the Troy Rotary Club which is over 100 years old

Bruce noted that next year the Ballston Spa Club will celebrate its 100th anniversary. He went on to say, "This year is about making it FUN." He urged our club to let Loraine and Bruce know our plans. They will be there to help.

Along the theme of FUN, Loraine introduced the district fundraiser...a new Rotary shirt imprinted with "a Rotarian at Work, making it Fun." It is available in all sizes and in several styles. An order blank will be in your in-box soon.
