

DR. SAM JACKSON, UALBANY THE OATH KEEPERS

Sam Jackson is an Assistant Professor in the



College of Emergency
Preparedness, Homeland
Security, and Cybersecurity
at the University at Albany.
He primarily studies far-right
extremism in America,
particularly anti-government
extremism. His writings
include the book *Oath*



Keepers: Patriotism and the Edge of Violence in a Right-Wing Antigovernment Group.

The Oath Keepers were founded in 2009 with the mission of "preventing the destruction American liberty by preventing full- blown totalitarian government from coming to power", feeling that our government, if not now, will become tyrannical. The founder and current leader is Stewart Rhodes (pictured right) a former paratrooper and Yale Law School graduate.



Membership is estimated to be 35,000, mostly white males, many with a military or police background. They participated in the 2014 Bundy Ranch Standoff, the 2016 Malheur Refuge Occupation, threw their support to Donald Trump in 2016, and of course were involved in the 1/6/2021 US capital insurrection, as part of Trump's "Stop-the-Steal" effort. Thirty-two members have been charged with federal crimes and are in the hands of the criminal justice system.

Oath Keeper inspiration is drawn from American History – particularly the American Revolution in which the British are portrayed as tyrants, and colonial revolutionaries as patriots. Think Boston Tea Party. In their "patriot" role, Oath Keepers are encouraged to prepare for conflict.
