VCHC - Michelle Viola-Straight

Our speaker is from our neighbor, **Veterans & Community Housing Coalition (VCHC)**. You will recognize the big, yellow house on Route 50 which has been housing female veterans since 1983, and is known as Guardian House. We learned about the soon-to-be-constructed Foreverly House, which will house homeless female veterans and their children.

Michelle Viola-Straight is the Acting Executive Director of VCHC. She is the mother of two sons currently serving in the military. She spoke passionately about the needs of veterans when they transition out of the service. VCHC support services for veterans include outreach to the homeless, or who are at-risk of becoming homeless, intensive short-term case management, financial-literacy training, job-search assistance, and linkage to Federal and other public benefits.

Michelle spoke about the special needs of female veterans – especially those with children. Guardian House is the first and only program for female veterans in the country, but it cannot house women and their children.

Foreverly House has been created with a grassroots effort, partnering with businesses, individuals as well as community leaders and groups. They

have no Veterans Affairs or other government funding. There is no other facility of this kind in New York State.

The goal of raising \$500,000 has been reached and construction will begin soon. Donations such as framing, roofing, painting, HVAC contractors, electricians, plumbing and more have been made. There may be an opportunity for our Rotary Club to provide service work like painting, donations of furnishings, etc.

Michelle told us that 26 female veterans with children have qualified for the Foreverly House. Two families will have the opportunity to live in the facility with a plan for their transition to permanent housing within two years. With the Guardian House close by there can be a peer-to-peer mentoring opportunity. Female veterans range in age from 22 to 92. The new house will be in the back of the property to provide a playground for the children. We will not see it from the road but there are two barns that are visible. These barns hold donations for the families in transition.
