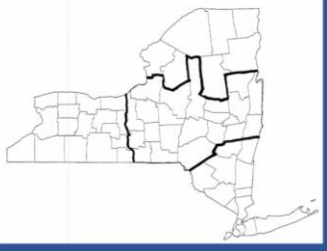

In response to loss of clubs and declining membership, Rotary Districts 7150, 7170 and 7190 are being rolled into a new entity, District CNY (Central New York). Whitney Pangburn is the DG Elect for our present District 7190 and is on a tour of the clubs. She becomes DG on July 1st.
